*CALL TO WORSHIP (Broken for Me, TFWS 2263)

Pastor: A table is set before us. **People: A feast is prepared for us.**

Congregation (singing): Broken for me, broken for you, the body of Jesus, broken for you. Come to the table and with me dine; eat of my bread and drink of my wine. Broken for me, broken for you, the body of Jesus, broken for you."(v.2)

Pastor: Come, now is the time to gather for this meal.
